The USW-Aggregation switch is designed for rack mounting in a standard 1U rack space. Secure the switch into your server rack using appropriate rack screws (not always included, depending on rack). An aggregation switch is a network device that consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or other edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers. It facilitates the connectivity because it would rapidly become impractical to interconnect all access switches in a full mesh of links without relying on an. An Aggregation or "Top-of-Rack" switch is designed to connect everything in a rack at high speeds, then have an even bigger pipe out to the rest of the network.
