An aggregation layer switch operates at the aggregation (or distribution) layer, typically between the access layer and the core layer, and can function at Layer 2 or Layer 3 of the OSI model.

Role in Network Hierarchy

Aggregation switches sit in the middle tier of a network, consolidating traffic from multiple access layer switches and forwarding it to the core layer . In a traditional three-tier network design, the hierarchy is:

- Access Layer: Connects end devices like computers, IP phones, and wireless access points.
- Aggregation (Distribution) Layer: Aggregates traffic from access switches, enforces policies, performs inter-VLAN routing, and applies security controls.
- Core Layer: Provides high-speed backbone connectivity between aggregation switches and other network segments.

OSI Layer Functionality

Aggregation switches can operate at Layer 2 (switching) or Layer 3 (routing) depending on network requirements . Layer 2 functionality includes VLAN tagging, link aggregation, and traffic forwarding within the same subnet. Layer 3 functionality allows for inter-VLAN routing, policy enforcement, and routing between different ne...
