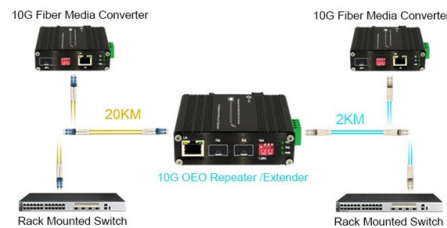

- **Interlock Armor** Interlocking metal strips wrap around the cable, providing enhanced tensile strength and crush resistance. This type is commonly used in indu...
