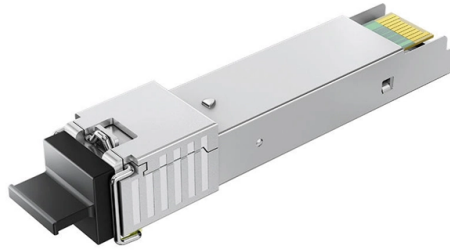


Which type of cable tray has better heat dissipation

Ladder-Type Cable Trays

Ladder trays consist of two side rails connected by rungs, creating an open structure that allows maximum airflow around cables. This design significantly improves heat dissipation, making it ideal for heavy power cables and long runs where overheating is a concern. The open rungs prevent thermal buildup, reduce insulation stress, and allow higher ampacity compared to enclosed systems, provided spacing and fill limits are respected. Ladder trays are commonly used in power plants, substations, and industrial facilities where ventilation is critical .

Wire Mesh Cable Trays

Wire mesh trays are made from welded steel wires, forming a grid that allows air to circulate freely. They are lightweight, flexible, and provide good ventilation, making them suitable for low-voltage and data cables in data centers and office buildings. While not as robust as ladder trays for heavy loads, their open structure still promotes effective heat dissipation .
