Climbers should be prepared for strenuous sections and occasional awkward route-finding, especially in areas where the rock is polished or slightly vegetated.

A typical ascent of a yellow-marked climbing slope may include:

- Initial pitches (V+ to VI-): Climbing polished yellow corners and overhanging cracks, often requiring precise footwork and hand placements. Belays are usually located on stances or terraces.
- Middle pitches (III+ to IV): Easier terrain with grey or slightly vegetated rock, moving right or left along ledges and small roofs. These sections often provide opportunities to rest and assess the next moves.

Tail stock alignment

Assuming your lathe is level (no bed twist) & doesn't cut a taper. Machine a piece of stock supported by the tailstock with a sharp cutter & skim cut to avoid excessive tool
